

NBTF Group Insurance Eligibility Guidelines for Supply Teachers

As a supply teacher, you become eligible for the New Brunswick Teachers' Federation (NBTF) Group Insurance Plan once you:

- Have registered with the New Brunswick Teachers' Association (www.nbta.ca) or l'Association des enseignantes et des enseignants francophones du Nouveau-Brunswick. AEFNB (www.aefnb.ca).
- Have worked at least one day in a New Brunswick school district and be on at least one of their approved supply lists.
- Contacted **Johnson Inc. directly at 1-888-851-5500** to inquire about the NBTF Group Insurance Plan.
(Evidence of insurability is not required, provided that application is made within 31 days of their first day of teaching. Teachers may enroll in Basic Life, Basic Accidental Death and Dismemberment (AD&D), Health and Prescription Drugs, Dental, Optional Life, and Optional AD&D Insurance Plans.)

In addition, please note:

- It is the supply teacher's responsibility to inquire about the New Brunswick Teachers' Federation Group Insurance Plan with Johnson Inc. directly.
- The Employer does not share in the cost of group insurance for a supply teacher.
- Supply teachers must provide proof that they have taught a minimum of 10 days in the previous school year in order to maintain their coverage for the following year. Otherwise, coverage will be cancelled.
- Should a supply teacher receive a contract, they must contact Johnson Inc. as soon as possible in order to ensure continuation of benefits in the NBTF Group Insurance Plan at **1-888-851-5500**.
